We will be running **two toddler/pre-school** music sessions during the morning (10:00-10:45 or 11:15-12:10). These will include singing known and new songs, learning action songs, playing instruments and listening to instruments together, with activities based on a 'Bear/Teddy Bear' theme. There will also be, within the session, a short instrument demonstration of the Euphonium.



Other members of the family are very welcome to attend to see what we do. In particular, within the second toddler/pre-school music session (starting 11:15), there will be a **ukulele taster session** offered to older siblings (school-age) and 'additional adults'. The aim will be to learn simple chords to accompany some of the songs that the children are learning and put it all together at the end!

These events also include a '**Bring a Friend**' option where other friends and their families are able to join in – please indicate any 'friends' when booking.

**All the activities** are free of charge, although donations are very welcome. Refreshments will be available. ### Music Makers Together @ Bridge House Care Home



Our special intergenerational sessions at Bridge House Care Home, run by Gillian and Helen, take place once per month on Fridays, 11.40-12.25. These are **FREE** pre-school music sessions for children under 5 with their parents, carers or grandparents and residents of Bridge House Care Home. This is open to members and non-members of Abingdon Music Centre.

Recent themes include Colours, Jungle, Teddies and Things That Go. We enjoy sharing traditional songs and rhymes together and encourage children and adults to join in with actions, props and instruments. We aim to get the children interacting with the residents, whether through playing peek-a-boo or sharing out scarves and instruments.





### **New Baby Music Class:**

We have just started a new baby class on Wednesday mornings. FREE for babies up to 4 months old. A great way to meet other families with little babies as well as start enjoying and learning about music together from an early age.

### **Community Band:**

We are hoping to start a Community Band, for children in Years 4+ up to adults. This would be in conjunction with Yamaha, to learn a woodwind instrument within a band setting. More details to follow but please contact the AMC office to register your interest.

### **Guitar Beginners:**

We still have spaces for beginners in the school-age Guitar Club and our adult classes.

## Hosted groups and classes:

We also host the following musical opportunities, run by our teacher / musician members:

- **Jazz Ensemble Playing Course** (Wednesday evenings)  
The emphasis of the course is on playing in a band and will cover playing well-known standards as well as some theory and ear-training along the way. For: those with little or no experience of playing jazz in a group; any instrumentalists or singers with reasonable technical ability; over 16s.
- **Abingdon Strings** (Alternate Saturdays 10.30-12.30 / 1-2pm)  
This is a fortnightly class, led by Marion Crombie and Valerie Findlay, for adult string players who want to play in a group primarily for pleasure rather than for exams. There is also a beginners group who meet at 1pm.
- **Abingdon Junior Orchestra / SOYS / SOYPA – see below**
- **Instrumental Lessons**  
Through our teacher members, lessons are offered in keyboard, woodwind, strings, brass, guitar, percussion and theory. Please contact the Abingdon Music Centre office, or see pages 13-14, for further details.
- **Rehearsal Space**  
If you want to play with a small group of musicians 'for fun, not for exams,' or simply need a practice space, that's possible too.

## Hosted Activities for School-aged children:

Abingdon Music Centre is delighted to work in partnership with Oxfordshire County Music Service to bring musical opportunities to school-aged children in Abingdon. We now host the Abingdon Junior Orchestra, SOYS and SOYPA at our music centre (Music Building at Larkmead School).

### Abingdon Junior Orchestra

Wednesdays 3.30-4.30pm  
This mixed instrument orchestra is for primary school players from beginner to grade 3. Free for those in the First Access programme (tuition through primary schools).



### South Oxfordshire Young Singers

Wednesdays 4.30-5.30pm  
SOYS is a group for enthusiastic and able primary aged singers in Y3-6 looking to challenge themselves beyond school choir and improve their vocal technique and musical ability by singing an exciting range of pieces in up to three-part harmony. There are performance opportunities at prestigious events and venues throughout the year including the Sheldonian and Oxford Town Hall.

### South Oxfordshire Young Performing Arts

Wednesdays 5.30-7pm  
SOYPA is open to young people in year 7, 8, 9 and 10 with an interest in performing arts. We welcome all abilities and you don't need to be able to read music. Singing is varied, covering a wide range of styles and part singing. Movement is for all abilities, developed through creative ideas as well as dance techniques. Pupils work on developing dramatic expression through improvisation.
